The risks include, but are not limited to, vehicular traffic and actions of participants, volunteers, spectators or organizers of the event. I hereby assume the risks of participating in the "Ride, for Pete's Sake!" to be held on August 16, 2008.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in this event, and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person.

For and on behalf of myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, I hereby waive, release and discharge from any and all liability for my death, disabilities, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me as a result of my participation in this event the following persons or entities: event sponsors, event organizers, event volunteers and all cities, counties, districts and states in which the event may be staged, and the officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents and volunteers of the foregoing. 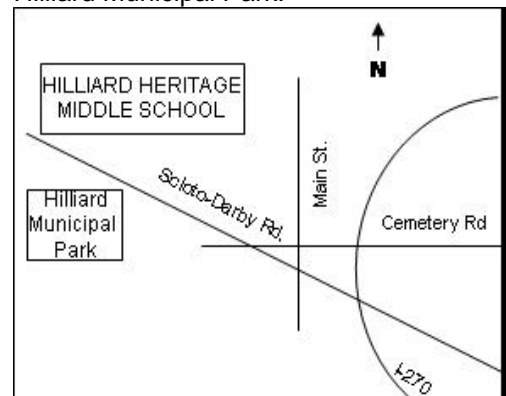
Ride 7, 17, 35, 48, 80, or 100 miles

**Routes and Services:** The "Ride, for Pete's Sake!" begins and ends at Hilliard Heritage Middle School (across from the Hilliard Municipal Park). The 7-mile route goes along the Heritage Rail Trail, passing through Homestead Park. The 17 and 35-mile routes are mostly flat jaunts to the scenic Big Darby Creek. The 48-mile route follows flat to gently rolling terrain on lightly traveled township roads, following the Big Darby toward its source. The 80 and 100-mile courses follow the same route with additional loops featuring longer grades. *All routes are marked with arrows on the road, and include a rest stop with refreshments and water. Don't miss the food at the start and the cookout following the ride.*

**Directions:** Hilliard Heritage Middle School is at 5670 Scioto Darby Rd slightly more than two miles west of I-270. From the Hilliard-Cemetery Road exit, drive west on Cemetery Road veer right onto Scioto-Darby Road (just after the intersection with Main Street). The school is across from Hilliard Municipal Park.

Dear Friends,

For 14 years, the Pedal-with-Pete (PwP) Foundation has been raising money for cerebral palsy (CP) research through bike-a-thons in Kent, Ohio and this year we are hosting our 7th annual Columbus ride. At the end of 2007, PwP disbursed \$60,000 to two research teams, one headed by Dr. Leland Albright and the other by Dr. Elizabeth Tyler-Kabarra. Thanks to the participation and generosity of thousands of riders and donors PwP has raised over \$400,000 dollars in these 13 years to support cerebral palsy research.

The need for CP research is great. Only about \$2 million dollars is targeted annually by the NIH (National Institute for Health) for CP research in the U.S. Research dollars for other conditions like MS or cystic fibrosis command two to four times as much. Cerebral palsy is a neurological condition that occurs during pregnancy or labor, or after birth, damaging the central nervous system and affects over 500,000 Americans.

This is why your involvement in Pedal-with-Pete makes such an impact.

There are so many ways to participate; your registration fee alone builds funds for research, **but by gathering sponsorship dollars from your friends and contacts, you can really make a difference.** You can also participate in the raffle for a great bike!
