Event-Day Volunteer	<i>Friendly, Outgoing</i>	<p>ONE DAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Saturday in late July or early August 4-8 hours, you choose. • Additional One-Day opportunities to-be-announced 	<p>Many different jobs to choose from. Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distribute food to the participants at one of several rest stops • Support riders on the road with your car • Help out with the post-event cookout. <p>Attitude of these volunteers is key to the spirit of the event. Pedal-with-Pete events are known for up-beat, friendly volunteers!</p>
General Volunteer	<i>Can-do attitude, Follow-through ability</i>	<p>Monthly meetings for about 6 months, in the evening.</p> <p>Commitment outside of meetings: averages 1 hour per month.</p>	<p>Provide input into the planning and execution of preparations throughout the year to create the event and other One-Day opportunities to raise awareness and funds for CP research. Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Several volunteers are needed to help secure door prizes by calling or visiting area businesses who have supported us in the past, or visiting new businesses. • Several volunteers are needed to help mark the bike routes in advance of the event for the cyclists. <p>Each Volunteer builds strong relationships within the team and contributes to the overall success of the event!</p>
Director Positions	<i>Initiative, Planner, Organizer</i>	<p>Monthly meetings for about 6 months, in the evening.</p> <p>Commitment outside of meetings: averages 2 hours per month.</p>	<p>Choose between several open leadership positions on the team. Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chair or Co-Chair of the Event • Volunteer Director • Fund Development Director • Entertainment Director • Cycling Support Director <p>Each Director leads an aspect of the event planning and execution. Effort builds a sense of teamwork, leadership capability, and ownership of the event's success!</p>
Board Member	<i>Leader, and Specialized skill such as Marketing, Medical, or Legal; or Connected to CP</i>	<p>Almost-Monthly Meetings, usually Tuesdays, 6:45 PM, in Hilliard, with some members attending through Skype or conference call.</p> <p>Commitment outside of meetings: averages 3 hours per month.</p>	<p>Oversee the Mission, Vision, Strategy. Make Connections to key donors, suppliers, promoters. Conduct the Grant-making process to CP researchers.</p> <p>Each Board Member feels the responsibility as well as the joy of helping so many people partner to fund cerebral palsy research.</p>
