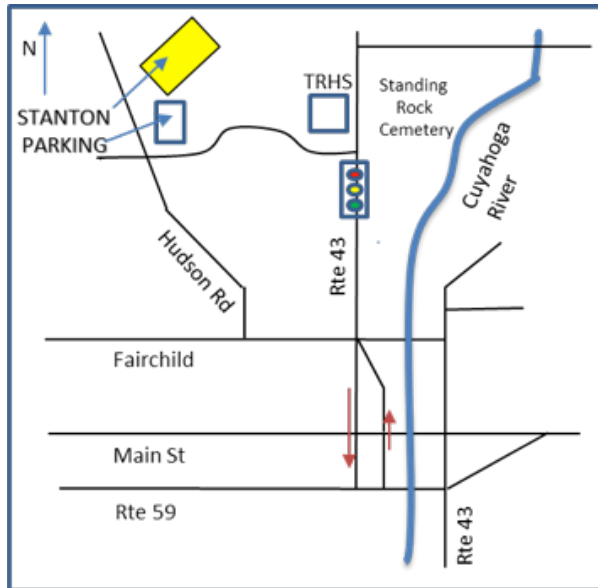
Bike: 6 - 62 miles (10 - 100 km)
